

INVITATION FOR BIDS
Town of Mendon, VT
Concrete Repair Work

The Town of Mendon (Town) is requesting quotes for concrete repair work at the Town of Mendon Garage, 157 Park Lane, and Mendon, VT.

The Contractor must have workman's compensation and insurance.

The Town Garage was constructed in 1983 with a poured concrete floor tapered to three floor drains. Over time wear and tear, salt and corrosive materials have pitted the floor surface requiring grinding and polishing to repair damage.

The proposed project work includes:

- Grind 4200 square feet: three bay garage and two small offices
- Grinding should involve starting with 16-25 grit metal bond diamonds and continue to about 80 grit metal bond.
- Transition to polish phase with diamond resins and finish polish at 400 grit
- Clean floor and apply densifier and salt resistant sealer.
- Provide sample test patch to be completed by Contractor to ensure adequate grinding can be done on the floor.
- Contract will be awarded by May 14th and work to be completed by June 30th.

Town will:

Clean floors with degreasers and hot pressure washer. Provide access by a qualified electrician to a double pole 30 amp breaker and single pole 20 amp breaker or similar based on contractor's needs.

A non-mandatory site visit to be held at the Town Garage at 157 Park Lane, Mendon, VT 05701 on April 24, 2018 at 8:30 AM.
