A. TO VOTE, completely fill in the OVAL to the RIGHT of your choice like this:

QUESTION

Shall the voters of the Barstow Unified Union School District AMEND Article 1, Section 10, Article 7, and Article 8 of the Articles of Agreement dated January 19, 2016 to provide for an additional at-large director as follows:

Article 1, Section 10

The Unified District shall be governed by a five (5) member Board of Directors.

B. Two (2) directors shall be elected by the voters of the Unified District on an at-large basis. Any legal voter of any member town shall be eligible to be elected as an at-large director.

The remaining terms and conditions of Article 1 shall remain in effect.

Article 7

At-Large Representatives: Two (2) directors shall be elected by the voters of the Unified District on an at-large basis. Any legal voter of any member town shall be eligible to be elected as an at-large director.

The remaining terms and conditions of Article 7 shall remain in effect.

Article 8

The initial term of service for the second at-large director shall be for two (2) years. Subsequent terms of service shall be for three (3) years.

The remaining terms and conditions of Article 8 shall remain in effect.

Election for this director position shall occur at the District's annual meeting in 2019.
