

Our School

Barstow Memorial School, long recognized for its academic excellence, is a PK-8 school of approximately 200 students located in rural Chittenden, Vermont. We serve students from the towns of Chittenden and Mendon, as well as tuition students from other surrounding areas. The original school building was built in 1933 with support from William and Francoise Barstow in memory of their only child, Frederic. Additions were made in 1939 and 1965. In 2002, construction began once again at the school to bring the existing facility into full compliance with all federal fire, health, safety, and architectural standards. The Barstow Unified Union district provides school choice for students to attend Vermont Agency of Education approved secondary schools.



Our Communities

The towns of Chittenden and Mendon are located in central Vermont in the heart of the Green Mountains. The towns are known for their beautiful mountain vistas, downhill (Killington Ski Resort) and cross-country (Mountain Top Inn Resort) skiing, hiking (Long Trail/Appalachian) and water sports (Chittenden Reservoir). You will also find lovely country inns, great eateries, and lots of family fun activities like maple sugaring and miniature golf. Residents and businesses are proud and supportive of Barstow Memorial School as shown by their volunteer efforts, most recently fundraising and contributing to the construction of a new school playground.
